

## Summerhill has a range of exciting activity sessions designed especially for primary school children.

Our core range of activities includes den building, archery, climbing, forest schools, storytelling and a wide variety of nature/conservation sessions. In addition we currently have some seasonal and curriculum specific sessions available.

These are bookable on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

## Spring/Summer

### Story Book Trails (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

The book choice ranges from Mad about Minibeasts to traditional tales to Julia Donaldson favourites. The sessions include a shared story, woodland games and crafts.



### What is a Tree – Woodland Habitats (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

This session looks at the importance of trees as habitats.



### Minibeast Detectives (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

Come on a hunt around Summerhill and discover the wonderful world of minibeasts



### Orienteering and Map Reading (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

Based on year 4 and 5 curriculum requirements for children to learn map reading skills.



### Forest Schools (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

Woodland activities and games.



### Den Building and Woodland Games (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

Fun session in the woodlands to improve team building, communication, design skills, imagination, motor skills etc.



### Language of Trees (EYFS, KS1, KS2)

Using all the children's senses to explore the woodlands and improve language and communication skills.

### Sessions bookable throughout the year:

#### Great Fire of London (KS1, KS2)

This is a 2 hour session with an introduction to the topic, den building and fire lighting skills. (Thursdays only) £125/class 25



#### History Heritage Days (KS1, KS2)

This 4 hour session gives an overview of the stone/bronze age/iron age. It is designed as an 'active session' where children explore the lifestyle in ages gone by. It includes a brief overview of the topic, orienteering to find hidden questions about the ages and den building. Fire lighting can also be included if requested.
